**LOCAL MEASURES CALENDAR OF EVENTS AND DEADLINES**

<b>Clerk of the Board Agenda Deadline:</b> Last day to file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors the original and twelve copies of the district boards resolution requesting consolidation with the election.	7/1/10
<b>Board of Supervisors Meeting:</b> Last meeting of the Board of Supervisors to approve the request for consolidation with the election.	7/13/10
<b>Publication-Notice of Election &amp; Notice to Submit Arguments:</b> Publication by County Elections of date for submission of direct arguments for and against the measure.	7/18/10*
<b>Period for Submitting Direct Arguments:</b> Direct arguments for and against the measure are to be submitted within this time frame.	7/19/10 – 7/28/10
<b>Preparation of Impartial Analysis:</b> Impartial Analysis prepared by legal counsel	7/28/10
<b>Period for Submitting Rebuttal Arguments:</b> Rebuttal arguments by the authors of the direct arguments are to be submitted within this time frame.	7/29/10 – 8/9/10
<b>10-Day Public Exam Period:</b> Period of public examination of proposed measure, analysis and arguments (if any).	8/10/10 – 8/19/10
<b>Election Official's Deadline for Submission of Local Measure Information to Printer:</b> Completion of submission of ballot/sample ballot order to printer by County Elections Official	8/20/10**

\* The dates beginning with the publication date may adjust by a few days earlier or later than the quoted date, affecting the events that follow by a few days. To verify the dates call the County Elections Office at (800) SBC-VOTE, (800) 722-8683.

\*\* The final date for the County Elections Official to have submitted all copy to the printer, as quoted on the above calendar, is firm.

**IMPORTANT NOTE FOR CITIES:**

Cities are responsible for the publication of the "Notice of Election" for their measures and the publication of the "Notice to Submit Arguments"; the receiving and processing of direct arguments/rebuttal arguments; the preparation of the Impartial Analyses and the 10-Day Public Examination Period. Due to this fact the cities' deadline for requesting consolidation with the election is the 88<sup>th</sup> day prior to Election Day (August 6, 2010). The last scheduled Board of Supervisors meeting prior to the 88<sup>th</sup> day is August 3, 2010. The deadline for submitting the cities resolution requesting consolidation with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the August 3, 2010 meeting is July 22, 2010. The City must submit a calendar of events and deadlines to the Elections Office by July 1, 2010.
